
Queensland Accommodation Report August 2023

The commercial accommodation industry in Queensland reported an increase in Occupancy Rates to 74.0 per cent for the August 2023 period (+2.6 percentage points compared to August 2022). Average Daily Rates (ADR) lifted to \$242.49 (+\$11.23 compared to August 2022) and Revenue Per Available Room (RevPAR) increased to \$179.42 (+\$14.24 compared to August 2022).

Compared to pre-COVID-19 performance from the August 2019 period, both the ADR and RevPAR indicators were higher in the current period, while Occupancy Rates were 1.2 percentage points below the level achieved in August 2019.

The Brisbane, Fraser Coast, Gold Coast, Mackay, Southern Great Barrier Reef, Southern Queensland Country, Sunshine Coast, Townsville and Tropical North Queensland regions reported steady or stronger levels of Occupancy Rate, ADR and RevPAR compared to August 2022.
