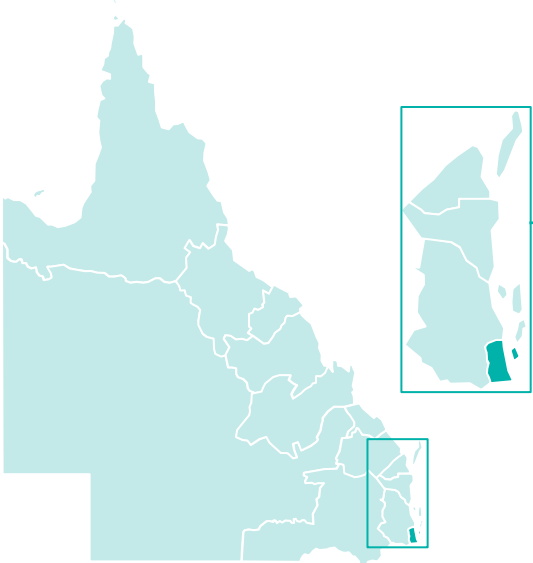
GOLD COAST KEY FACTS



In 2018-19, the tourism industry contributed an estimated **\$5.0 billion** to the Gold Coast regional economy (14.4% of Gold Coast's gross regional product) and supported about **43,700 jobs** (15.0% of employment in Gold Coast).

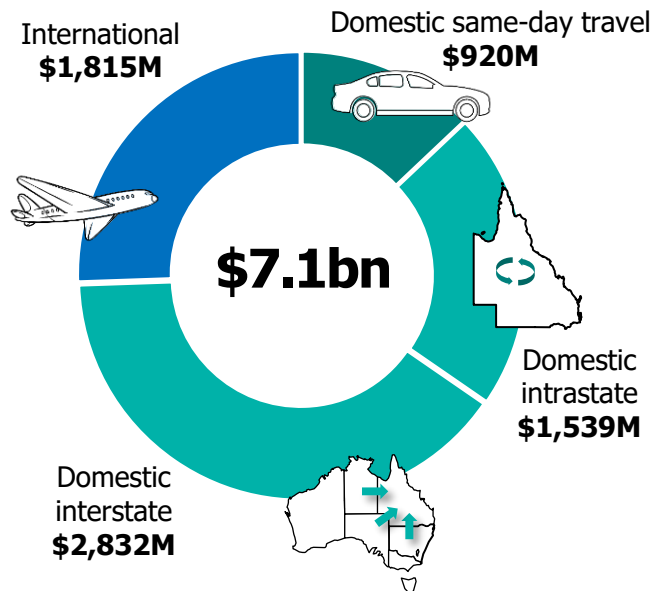
